## **UNITY - OUR NEED**

Tuesday, September 27, 2022

Unity is elusive. Hard to create and hard to keep going. Unity happens when a group of people feel connected to accomplish a purpose. According to Merriam-Webster dictionary the meaning of unity is: the quality or state of not being multiple: the quality or state of being one, single, whole, or the same only if there is unity of ownership of the immovable and movables.

The Bible speaks of unity with the complexity of having diversity at the same time. The many becoming one or working as one 1 Corinthians 12:14-19 says:

<sup>14</sup> Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.

<sup>15</sup> Now if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. <sup>16</sup> And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. <sup>17</sup> If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? <sup>18</sup> But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. <sup>19</sup> If they were all one part, where would the body be? (1 Corinthians 12:14-19 NIV).

The notable example of this in art is a mosaic. A picture made up of many different pieces and colors to create a picture. The body of Christ is certainly made up with many unique and yes, sometimes strange parts. Now Paul is referring to both needing each other and utilizing our Spiritual gifts together to accomplish Christ's will. I wonder if your congregation is using all the parts of the body that Christ has gifted you with? For the church, the

body, to be healthy every part needs to be fulfilling its part, i.e., their spiritual gifts or their talents.

Looking back over my years of ministry one thing comes to mind is that pianos at retreat centers are often neglected due to lack of funding. As each camping season passes and hundreds of kids mercilessly pound that piano, eventually there are missing keys. Have you ever tried playing a piano that has missing notes? Now I'm not the greatest piano player but even I have found it frustrating and a struggle to play a tune with any sense of artistic flare. To be frank it sounds awful. So, it is with the church when people aren't using their gifts and talents the Lord has provided for the church's ministry.

Just like the body needs both an eye and an ear to function properly, so does the body of Christ. The truth of the matter is that You need me and I need you for our church, our spiritual body, to be healthy and whole.

## **UNITY - OUR LOVE**

(Romans 15:1 NIV) We who are strong ought to bear with the failings of the weak and not to please ourselves.

(1 Peter 4:8-10 NIV) <sup>8</sup> Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. <sup>9</sup> Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. <sup>10</sup> Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

(Colossians 3:12-14 NIV) <sup>12</sup> Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. <sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

Loving people isn't always easy. Yes, there are some we just naturally love because we like them, feel good when we're with them. Trust them and hope they know they can trust us. Why? Because we love them. Love is the foundation for true long-lasting unity. Love in a marriage or in a church can make all the difference.

Some people are just difficult to love. They may have a nasty disposition, or they are so deeply hurt that they just repel everyone around them and spew venom everywhere they go. These people are hard to trust, hard to be around, and hard to love. They make it their mission in life to push everyone else away and make everyone miserable in the process.

The verses that were read aloud seem to imply that we are to love everyone in the church family. To put up with each other, forgive each other, be patient with each other, and most importantly whether we like them or not, love each other. That must be a supernatural, powered by the Holy Spirit, accomplishment. Where we tend to be prideful and selfish the scripture is challenging us to be humble and thinking of others first. Colossians 3:14 reminds us that it is love which binds us together in unity. The King James Version says it's the "bond of perfectness." Bonds hold things in place. Love is that perfect bond which enables us to put up with each other's idiosyncrasies. Trust me when I say, "We need the Holy Spirit in our lives to love each other in the church." Unity in the church of Jesus Christ is held together with the bond of perfectness...that is love!

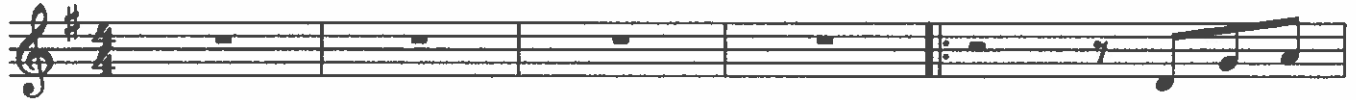
